

# WHAT'S YOUR COPAY?

Knowing the copay level for your prescription drug is easy. It can also save you money. Just remember:

- Tier 1 your lowest cost option, includes mainly generic medications and a few brand-name drugs
- Tier 2 offers more brand-name options, including preferred brands and some generics
- Tier 3 the most costly option with non-preferred brand medications
